



COVID-19 (Coronavirus) - Precautionary measures in place for services

We are aware of the prayer and consultation, we have decided hold church this Sunday with precautions in place recommended by the government and health authorities. However if you would rather not attend, because you are not well, you are in a vulnerable category or for any other reason, you will be able to listen to the service on podcast. We will continue to monitor the situation and update you with any further changes.

- ◆ We are recommending parents NOT to bring children to church as per HSE guidelines.
- ◆ There will be no children's activities or youth activities for the next fortnight.
- ◆ Doors will be held open for you by our Welcome Team to avoid contact with handles. We discourage any physical touch when welcoming each other such as handshakes or hugs.
- ◆ Offering baskets will not be passed round but located in various places in the church.
- ◆ We will make alternative space if over 100 people.
- ◆ There will be no tea or coffee after service to try and avoid social interaction.
- ◆ Please wash your hands more often than usual, 20 seconds each time with soap and water. Hand sanitiser is available throughout the building, use it often.
- ◆ Please do not attend church if you or someone close to you has the virus symptoms such as: a high temp, shortness of breath & a new, continuous cough.
- ◆ Those who have underlying health challenges should consider the wisdom of being in large crowds and stay at home.
